Registrations accepted from November 4, 2009 through December 11, 2009*

Come and join us on one of the major Father/Daughter events of the year! We will stay at the Cascade Village, condominiums. Each unit has a fully-equipped kitchen, great room, bedrooms, and bathrooms. This trip is for non-skiers as well as skiers and snowboarders. Activities may include skiing, snowboarding, cross-country skiing, snowshoeing, hiking, snowmobiling, and sleigh rides. Come and enjoy a fun and memorable weekend with your daughter.

Registration fee includes travel by bus, lodging, Friday evening welcome buffet, Saturday dinner, three breakfasts-Sat,Sun,Mon., ski rentals, on-mountain lunch (included with lift ticket purchase) and lessons are available, if desired. Purgatory Mountain is a great place for beginners to learn to ski or the more experienced to test their skill. The resort has excellent instructors and the mountain has terrain suitable for all levels. Discounted rental equipment and group lessons are available as an option on the registration form. Your pre-paid rental equipment will be waiting for you at the resort when we arrive on Friday night. You must book your lessons and rental equipment when you register to receive the group rates.

Travel to Durango and back will be on luxury motor coaches. We will depart Xavier on Friday, January 15th at 6:30AM. You should arrive by 5:30AM to find your bus assignment, stow your gear on your assigned bus and be ready to leave on time. Once on the road, movies and music are available. Girls are encouraged to bring their favorite DVDs that are acceptable to all audiences. We will stop in Kayenta for a quick lunch and plan to arrive at Cascade Village by 5:00PM. Room assignments and information packets will be distributed on the buses so you can go directly to your room. A welcome reception followed by a dinner buffet is included at Cascade Village Friday evening for everyone to unwind and get ready for a full weekend of skiing.

Lifts open at 9:00 a.m. Our tour buses will be available to take us from Cascade Village to the lifts and bring us home at the end of the day. Once at the mountain, you will find lessons, food and souvenirs. You can choose to ski both Saturday and Sunday, just one day or not at all. A BBQ lunch will be served at Woody's Base Camp at the base of the mountain Saturday and Sunday and this cost is included in your lift ticket price.

Mass will also be available Saturday evening. Advance dinner reservations are strongly recommended. A catered group dinner is included Saturday night. On Sunday night, the seniors and their dads are invited to the Sow's Ear restaurant for the traditional Senior Dinner Celebration.

We will return on Monday, January 18th, 2009. All students are expected to be back in school at 8:00 a.m. on Tuesday, January 19th, with their homework complete.

You must register on-line. Once you complete your on-line registration you will be emailed forms that must be signed, notarized and turned in to Ms. Nancy Lockman at Xavier. If space runs short as we expect it to, preference will be given to those who register early. Due to pre-payment commitments, there are no refunds

after December 11th 2009. Registrations received after December 11, 2009 will be on a space available basis at additional cost. Join the fun; spend some time with your daughter, her friends, and their dads!!

The Father/Daughter Ski Trip is for fathers (or male guardian) and daughters. Mothers, brothers, and boyfriends are not permitted on this trip. One father may take and be responsible for up to two Xavier students. These may be sisters or a daughter and a friend who is in need of a responsible parent to participate.

ROOM MATE PREFERENCES

We will make every attempt to put students requesting to room together in the same condominium. Our young ladies will share a condominium that sleeps four to eight girls. This puts two girls in some beds when large enough and utilizes sleeper sofas. Girls will be assigned condominiums with other girls in the same graduating class to the greatest extent possible. Dads are generally assigned condominiums having the other dads who have girls rooming together. This allows dads to meet the dads of their daughter's friends. Each dad will have his own bed. Dads will not be utilizing sofa beds.

The 3-day breakfast package is included this year. The base price includes all three mornings for one person. Discounted group lessons are offered by the world famous Durango Mountain Resort ski school. Please indicate your preference for ski or snowboard lessons, whether you would like half or full day lessons and your ability level. 1. There will be a minimum of one (1) dad/male guardian for every two students
2. There will be one (1) adult at the hotel at all times to handle any medical emergencies.
3. Curfew is 11:00 p.m. At this time, all girls will be in their rooms and the dads will conduct a bed check.
No one may leave room after bed check.
4. Each student is allowed one (1) suitcase which will be checked by the dads and faculty before leaving Friday morning.
5. Students may take only backpack and books on the bus with them. They will be checked before leaving for Durango Mountain Resort.
6. Any student who breaks any XCP Handbook Rule will be subject to dismissal from Xavier and, could possibly, be sent home by plane at parent expense.
7. All students must be in school on time on Tuesday, January 19, 2010. (Rule 7 will apply to attendance Tuesday, January 19, 2010).

Statement of Understanding and Agreement

1. The Father/Daughter Ski Trip is ONLY for daughters whom are current Xavier College Preparatory students and their father (or male guardian). Sisters whom are not Xavier students, mothers, brothers, and boyfriends are not permitted on this trip. One father may take and be responsible for up to two Xavier students. These may be sisters or a daughter and a friend who is in need of a responsible parent to participate.
2. The last official day for registering for the Father/Daughter Ski Trip is Friday, December 11th, 2009. After this date, there is no guarantee that you can participate—registrations will be handled on a space available basis.
3. Due to pre-payment commitments, there are no refunds after December 11th, 2009.
4. An incidental/damage release waiver will be required from all individuals. Your trip registration cannot be processed without one.
5. All lodging for the Father/Daughter Ski Trip is to be arranged through the Father/Daughter Ski Trip group leader.
6. Daughters' roommate preferences will be honored strictly on a 'first-come, first-serve' basis. The earlier you register for the Father/Daughter Ski Trip, and the earlier your daughter's preferred roommates register, the better chance they have of rooming together. Even though the Father/Daughter Ski Trip planning committee has the best intentions and does the best it can to honor all roommate requests, THERE IS NO GUARANTEE YOUR ROOMMATE REQUESTS WILL BE HONORED IN WHOLE OR PART.
7. All rooms are assigned based on the daughters' roommate preferences (whenever possible) and date registered (preference is given to early registrations). There will be absolutely NO SWITCHING OF ROOMS permitted by either dads or daughters without specific consent of the Father/Daughter Ski Trip group leader.
8. Every dad will have his own bed. Most daughters will need to double-up with other daughters in king beds, queen beds, and sleeper sofas. No sleeper sofas are required to be used by dads.
9. Neither Durango Mountain Resort nor Cascade Village will provide individuals any refunds of prepaid trip expenses. Individuals are not to solicit Durango Mountain Resort or Cascade Village for any refunds of prepaid trip expenses.
10. Curfew is 11:00pm. At this time, all girls will be in their rooms and each dad will conduct a bed check for their daughter. No one may leave their room after bed check.
11. Guest accommodations at Cascade Village will be available at 4:00pm on arrival day and reserved until 11:00am on departure day.
12. All students are expected to be back in school at 8:00am on Tuesday, January 19, with their homework complete.
13. Any changes in mode of travel from what is reported on your trip registration form for either dad or daughter must be communicated to the Father/Daughter Ski Trip group leader.
