

# RULES OVERVIEW

- This is a Xavier excursion authorized by the Diocese of Phoenix and sponsored by the XCP Dads' Club.
- · We must comply with and enforce all the guidelines handed to us.
- ONLY Dads and Daughters registered through the process and with forms on file will be authorized to join us during the trip.
- Unregistered Dads, students, and other family members who travel independently or attempt to join us in reserved group locales while at Durango Mountain/Purgatory Resort must be prohibited access.
- Any attempts by unauthorized personnel to enter, or by registered Dads/Daughters to aid someone to do so, are a violation of Xavier policy and will be enforced with significant consequences.

# DRINK RESPONSIBLY



- Alcoholic beverages are not permitted in the passenger compartment of the motor coaches at any time, but they may be transported in packed luggage in the luggage stow compartments below the bus to/from Durango.
- Dads are expected to conduct themselves in a courteous and considerate manner and drink responsibly.
- Remember--you are with your daughters. Don't be "that" Dad.

# REMINDERS



• Dress warmly in layers and bring appropriate footwear onto the bus before departure.

• Bring sunscreen and sunglasses for snow glare protection. Severe sunburn occurs at altitude even on partly sunny days.

• Altitude sickness is real! Drink lots of water before and during trip.

• The girls must comply with all XCP Handbook rules at all times during the trip to/from and during our stay in Durango, no exceptions. Any violations will be reported to XCP.

# TRIP TRAVEL LOGISTICS TO DURANGO



- Please be at XCP by 5:30 AM for loading on Friday, Jan 12.
- You can leave your car at Xavier, it will be locked behind the gates all weekend.
- Buses leave XCP as soon as we are fully boarded ~6 AM.
- We stop for bus pictures about 2 hours into the trip.
- We stop in Kayenta for a quick lunch in both directions
- Bus assignments are set by grade. (1 senior; 1 junior; 1 soph; 1 soph/frosh, 1 frosh)
- Rosters will be set. Roll call will occur at each stop. There is absolutely no changing buses.
- There will be two bus captains on each bus
- Be ready for subzero weather and possibly snow when we get to Purgatory...don't pack your jackets under the bus
- We should arrive at Purgatory Resort by ~5 PM
- Buses arrive back at XCP by ~5 PM on Monday, Jan 15

# **SELF-TRANSPORTS**





- Our contact at Purgatory Resort, Jill Burkhart, will be available at the <u>Purgatory Lodge Front Desk</u> from about noon until 3 pm on Friday, Jan 12<sup>th</sup>, then in <u>Hoody's</u> in Village Center.
- She will have a separate box of welcome packets for all "self-transports". Rooms should be ready by 4 pm.
- For drivers...snow tires or 4-wheel drive are strongly recommended.
- If you fly, you need to arrange transport to and from the airport. Uber and Lyft seem to work and be reasonably affordable.

# ARRIVAL AT PURGATORY



- We expect to arrive at Durango by about 5 pm.
- Buses will pull into the Gelande lot (overflow parking) near the main road.
- Packets will be distributed, and shuttle assignments included.
- 3 shuttles will take everyone in small groups up to their buildings. Shuttles have been assigned by lodging location for efficiency.




# ARRIVAL AT PURGATORY



- Shuttles organized by building...dropoff at condo.
- Bring bags to room.
- Come back to Hoody's for reception (in Village Center).
- Release (in bus order) from Hoody's to get in line to pick up rentals.
- Bring ski rentals to ski storage (\$25 for weekend), or into ski locker assigned to condo, or back to room (store on balcony, not in room). Take boots/helmet with you back to room.
- Come back to Hoody's for reception.
- Dinner to start at DMI around 6:45 PM.

# ARRIVAL AT PURGATORY



- Once we arrive at Purgatory, we will have exclusive use of the rental shop to expedite the rental and fitting process. During the rental fittings, appetizers and beverages will be served in Hoody's.
- Registration packets will be passed out before you disembark the bus. The packets will contain room keys/door codes, lift tickets and confirmation of rental/lessons/activity reservations.
- Once you have your packet you are considered to have all of your items. Look through the packet immediately. If something is missing it MUST be identified and noted right away.
- Brian Cantoni will go to Hoody's after getting his rentals, and be in contact with Jill on any issues.
- Please do not leave your packet on the bus, take it with you.

- All lodging will be in Purgatory Village area, on the slopes.
- All Condos are ski-in/ski-out located at the Village
- For Girls' rooms, sleeping capacity is by number of pillows
- For Dads' rooms, sleeping capacity is by number of beds
- Beds can be king, queen, twin, double, or bunk.
- Roommate preferences were collected during registration and strongly considered
- Room/roommate assignments have already been distributed.
- We have limited history with some of the rooms. Please note any mistakes in instructions or issues we should know about for future years.
- Check in time for most units is 4 pm.
- There are NO changes to rooms or roommates, absent permission. All requested changes <u>must</u> be cleared with Brian Cantoni.

# WI-FI, INTERNET ACCESS AND CELL PHONES

- Connection on the mountain may also be spotty. Some carriers work better than others; Verizon seems to work best.
- Mass texting will be a method used for communications during the trip

# **DMI**



Durango Mountain Institute (DMI)/Purgatory Village Community Clubhouse

- The Dads' Club has rented this clubhouse in the center of the Elk Point Townhomes exclusively for REGISTERED Xavier Dads and Daughters.
- It has ski-in and ski-out access and is next to the base of Needles Lift (lift 6).
- It is open on Friday from 3 pm 10 pm, and then 9:00 am 10 pm Saturday and 9:00 am 11:30 pm Sunday.
- This two-level building offers exclusive use of the large screen televisions; indoor and outdoor tables; warm/dry shelter during your activity breaks; a staffed cash bar, and a location for us to provide snacks, free water, Gatorade, soft drinks
- Note: Due to required enforcement of Diocesan and Xavier rules, food costs and our arrangement with DMR, we can only allow registered Xavier Dads and Daughters access to








# PHOTOS ON THE MOUNTAIN

- Outside DMI on Sun. afternoon at Noon




# OPTIONAL FUN
