## **Travel** Lead: Sean Kaul (Bus Czar)



### **Option 1 – Bus (Included in Registration)**

- Depart: Friday, Jan 17<sup>th</sup> @ 6a from XCP
  - Two stops: Picture @ Sedona Rest Stop + Lunch @ Kayenta
  - Arrive Purgatory by ~5p Friday evening
- Return: Monday, Jan 20<sup>th</sup> @ ~6p to XCP
  - One stop: Lunch @ Kayenta
- There will be two bus captains on each bus
- Bus assignments are set by grade
- Rosters set for each bus with roll call at each stop so we don't leave anyone behind – stay on assigned bus
- Can leave cars locked in Xavier lot over weekend

### **Option 2 – Self Transport via Fly/Drive (Additional)**


- Nearest airport: Durango-La Plata County Airport (DRO)
- If switch after registration, make sure you let Jason Smith and Rick Olson know





- Lodging: In Purgatory Village area on the slopes
  - Girls: Sleeping capacity is by number of pillows
  - Dads: Sleeping capacity is by number of beds
  - Beds can be king, queen, double, twin, bunk (some units might have sleeper sofas but we aren't counting)
- Roommates: Preferences will be collected during registration and will be considered but not guaranteed
- Thursday Night Arrivals: If going up on your own and want to stay Thursday night, that can be arranged – notify during signup

- Unregistered Dads, students, and other family members who travel independently or attempt to join us in reserved group locales while at Durango Mountain/Purgatory Resort will be asked to leave – didn't pay, not covered by insurance and puts future trips at risk

### **Base Registration Cost**

- Non-Dads' Club Big Gator Member: \$1,199/person

#### **Registration Schedule**

- Early Bird: From this meeting, you are able to access early registration (email w/ link coming 10/18) 3 PM – 6 PM on Saturday, October 19th
- General: Others can register starting at 6 AM on Monday, October 21st
- Waitlist: Will start at 320 registrants either during Early Bird or General

- <u>Trip becomes non-refundable as of November 11th</u>



## **Registration Preparation**



Be prepared. The trip will likely sell out quickly.

### For registration, prepare seven things:

- 1. Email addresses, cell phone numbers and birthdates of all participants (for you and your daughters)
- 2. Identify an Emergency contact
- 3. A decision if you will ride the bus or self transport
- 4. If you are renting equipment, the height, weight and shoe size for all registrants
- 5. List of names with whom you and your daughter(s) would like to room
- 6. Dietary restrictions
- 7. The credit card you will use for payment
